Summary Statements

Rainfall for December 2019:

Near normal rainfall was recorded at most of the places. The exceptions to this were Vunisea and Ono-i-Lau in the Eastern Division and Savusavu Airfield in the Northern Division with above normal rainfall, while Rotuma received below normal rainfall.

Vunisea registered its fourth wettest December on record.

Accumulated rainfall for October to December 2019, including outlook verification:

Rainfall was *normal* to *below normal* in the Western Division, while *normal* to *above normal* falls were recorded in the Eastern Division. There was a mix of *below normal* and *above normal* totals in the Central and Northern Divisions, while Rotuma recorded *above normal*.

The outlook issued in August were 'near-consistent' at four stations, 'consistent' at three stations, and 'inconsistent' at six stations.

Outlooks for February to April 2020:

1. SCOPIC:

The outlooks for the **Western Division, Labasa** in the **Northern Division** and **Lakeba** and **Vunisea** in the **Eastern Division** show *below normal* rainfall as the most likely outcome followed by *near normal* as the next most likely. At **Suva** in the **Central Division**, the outlook is mixed, with near-equal chances of *above normal* and *below normal* rainfall.

For remaining sites in the **Central, Eastern and Northern Divisions**, together with **Rotuma**, the outlook offers little guidance as the chances of *below normal*, *normal* and *above normal* rainfall are similar.

2. POAMA:

Below normal rainfall is favoured at Nadi, Vunisea, Suva and Rotuma.

At Lakeba and Udu Point, the outlook is mixed with near-equal chances of *below normal* and *above normal* rainfall; *near normal* is the least likely.

At Nabouwalu, there are near-equal chances of near normal and below normal rainfall.
